Prerequisite: Literacy skills below grade level. Year 1-2 Semester: Fall
Fundamentals in coherent sentence and paragraph written expression while emphasizing grammatical structure, spelling, vocabulary with clarity, precision, and fluency.
- ENG 020-021 LITERATURE AND WRITING SE A-B Credit: 1.00
Prerequisite: Literacy skills below grade level. Year 1-2 Semester: Winter
Fundamental literary analysis while structuring written arguments in a logical, sustained, and persuasive discussion.
- ENG 030 READING DEVELOPMENT SE Credit: 0.50
Prerequisite: Literacy skills below grade level. Year 1 Semester: Summer
Fundamental effective reading skills in comprehension, word attack, fluency, and speed.
- ENG 040 WRITING DEVELOPMENT SE Credit: 0.50
Prerequisite: Literacy skills below grade level. Year 2 Semester: Summer
Fundamental effective writing skills with concise grammatical and compositional structure.

Prerequisite: English 6 Year 1-2 Semester: Fall
Introduction to sentence structure and multi-paragraph writing, with emphasis on spelling, punctuation, vocabulary, and grammar usage.
- ENG 060-061 LITERATURE AND WRITING A-B Credit: 1.00
Prerequisite: English 6 Year 1-2 Semester: Winter
Introduction to the elements, forms, devices, style, and criticism of literary themes.
- ENG 070 ESSAY WRITING Credit: 0.50
Prerequisite: English 6 Year 1 Semester:
Introduction to narrative, descriptive, expository, and persuasive compositional writing.
- ENG 072 WRITING DEVELOPMENT Year 1-2 Semester: Summer
Prerequisite: English 6
Introduction of writing strategies and usage to increase overall written expression, with concise grammatical and compositional structure.
- ENG 080 CREATIVE WRITING Credit: 0.50 (elective)
Prerequisite: English 6 Year 2 Semester: Summer
Introduction to original writing in various genres including short story, poetry, and prose.
- ENG 085 APPLIED COMMUNICATION
Prerequisite: English 6
Introduction to Powerpoint and word processing using: writing skills, poetry, short stories, informational text, and presentations.
- ENG 090 SECONDARY READING Credit: 0.50 (elective)
Prerequisite: English 6 Year 2 Semester: Summer
Fundamental and effective skills in the comprehension of non-fiction, fiction, and functional texts. Students will learn word attack, and spelling and vocabulary strategies. Students will learn to identify, compare and contrast, cause and effect relationships, literary sequencing, and other internal text structures.
